Show grounds gate will be closed between 12:00 (midnight) and 6:00 a.m. on Friday & Saturday evenings.

*****Electricity may not be piggybacked. Water may be.** The electrical, water and sewer hookups throughout the park are controlled by the North Florida Fairgrounds. The Ochlockonee River Kennel Club of Florida cannot guarantee the functionality or capacity of the available outlets but will make every effort to ensure that all work. To maximize access to water where possible, the ORKC suggests the use of water T's to permit sharing of spigots. Water T's are not furnished by the club, exhibitors must supply their own. It is recommended that motor homes bring at least 100' of water hose and 100' of heavy duty electrical cord.*** (hookups available for 30 & 50 amps)

*Shower facilities are available.

*There is a Dump Station on the grounds and there are a few sewer hookups.

*Violations or theft of electricity (including piggybacking) or trash/sewage dumping except at designated areas will be subjected to an Event Committee Hearing.

*Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up their parking areas. When leaving the fairgrounds, please leave your trash in closed garbage bags at your parking site.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

Directions: From I-10: Exit at Exit #199 SR 27 (North Monroe Street) and go South until you see the fairgrounds entrance (approximately 9 miles).

From Hwy. SR61: Follow the signs for Thomasville Road South and pass under I-10. Continue south on Thomasville Road until it merges into Monroe St. Follow Monroe Street south until you see the entrance to the fairgrounds.

From the east or west: Capital Circle (Hwy. 319) circles Tallahassee. When you reach Capital Circle; go south until you reach SR 61. Go north until you see the fairgrounds entrance.

Move-Ups

Move-ups will be allowed for this trial but must be sent in writing/email to the trial secretary no later than 6 p.m. Monday, February 22nd, 2010. Day to day move-ups will be accepted over the trial weekend.

BITCHES IN SEASON Upon receipt of a written statement from a Vet postmarked before the date of the show, a refund will be made minus a \$8.00 processing fee.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

How do I know if I have a valid jump height card?

If your dog is under the age of two years as of the trial's date: One (1) temporary measurement is required. Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow copy and check "My dog has a **Temporary** Jump Height Form" box, otherwise your dog needs to be measured. If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date, your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

If your dog is the age of two years or older as of the trial's date: A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required. If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card. If not, then a third measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. Until such time that you have received all required measurements for a permanent jump height card, check the "My dog needs to be measured" box. Upon arrival at the trial, you must check to see if there is a Volunteer Measuring Official and/or an Agility Field Rep. present to perform official measurements. If not, and you possess a yellow copy of the Agility Measurement Form from a previous measurement, then your armband may be picked up during Check-In in lieu of being measured by the judge of record. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement: If your dog measures over 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the "Over 22" Reqst Perm" box at the top left corner of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement. If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox. By doing so, you are giving up your right to have a 2nd measurement performed on your dog in the future; however, you are not giving up your right to have the challenge measurement process performed in the future. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms

**** NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS ****

ENTRY FEE \$25.00 for the first entry per day and \$15.00 for each additional entry of the same dog for the same day (includes \$3.00 per run AKC recording fees)

MAKE ALL CHECKS & MONEY ORDERS payable to "ORKC".

All fees are to be payable in **U.S. Funds**. **ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE, INCOMPLETE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted and will be returned.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the **Agreement and Rules** on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form is **NOT ACCEPTABLE** and **WILL BE RETURNED!**

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC or ILP/PAL number.

DOGS LESS THAN 6 MONTHS OF AGE ARE PROHIBITED AT AKC AGILITY TRIALS.

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations For Agility Trials.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to Judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dog are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship is the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
